

Iver Golf Club & Academy Procedures of Play

Please read below for the procedures that must be adhered to play golf at Iver Golf Club.

- ADVANCE and PRE-PAID bookings are required to play golf at Iver Golf Club.
- You must pay for your tee time booking online or over the phone, no cash will be accepted.
- Driving Range open with limited bays available, advisable to pre-book to avoid disappointment.
- Payment for Driving Range by contactless only. No cash will be accepted.
- Only 1 person per bay allowed on the driving range.
- Only 9holes will be permitted per person, with a maximum time of 2hrs.
- You must leave the facility as soon as you have finished your round.
- Our facilities will be open daily from 7:30am with last tee time at 5pm. The gates will close at 7:30pm.
- The bar and restaurant will remain closed. There will be limited purchases only, including bottled drinks and snacks.
- Please take all your waste away with you for safe disposal.
- Contactless payments only. We will not accept cash.
- Buggies, trolleys, and clubs will be not be available for hire.

In accordance with Government restrictions and the latest guidance provided by England Golf, the following procedures will be in place at the club until further notice:

- You must not visit the club without a pre-booked tee time.
- The entrance gate will remain closed, only allowing those who have pre-booked to enter the facility.
- You may play in one of the following permitted groups:
 - As a single player
 - As a 2-ball comprising of two people from different households. Observing 2-metre social distancing at all times
 - We will not accept 3 or 4 ball bookings
- You will not be allowed to bring additional friends or family members to join you for a walk/caddie during your round.
- Tee Time intervals will be spaced at 15 minutes.
- Your arrival should be no more than 15 minutes before your booked tee time.
- No competitive golf shall be played until further notice.
- All bunker rakes have been removed from the courses. Please use your foot or club to smooth over.
- There are no tee markers, please play from the best position.
- No contact should be made with the flag/pin on any hole. All cups have been overturned to help you remove your ball safely.
- All communal areas of the Clubhouse are closed except to staff. The toilets are open if needed.
- Only cashless payments will be accepted, either by contactless credit/debit card.

- Wherever possible we have marked designated waiting and queuing areas and a one-way route around and in the clubhouse. These will always be used.
- Score cards will not be available.
- You must not share your clubs.

Golf Rules

- 2 ball only
- 2hr play maximum – 9 holes only
- Scorecards not provided – keep your own scores, do not exchange
- Tees – markers removed, use best position
- Stableford & match play only – avoid stroke play
- Bunkers – no rakes, make good with feet or clubs
- Greens – do not touch flagpoles, hole cups are upside down to get balls easily, allow a gimme of up to 2ft
- General – maintain your distance, do not touch stray balls, do not use the bins, and do not share your clubs!

End of Game Rules

- You must leave facility after your round of golf
- Please take all waste away with you

Driving Range Rules

- Limited bays open
- Advisable to pre-book to avoid disappointment
- 50 balls maximum per person
- 1 person per bay
- Maximum 40 minutes
- Please return basket to reception
- Observe social distancing at all times
